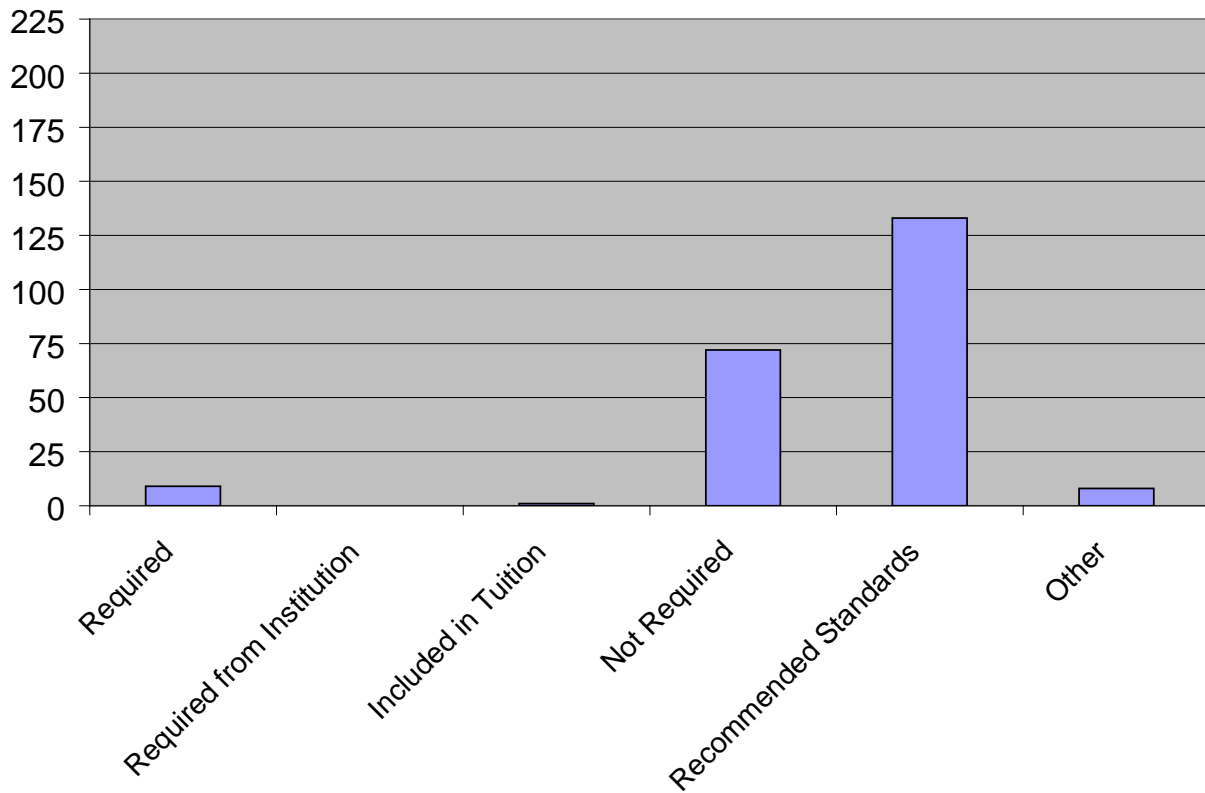


**80. Are all students at your institution required to purchase or provide a computer?**

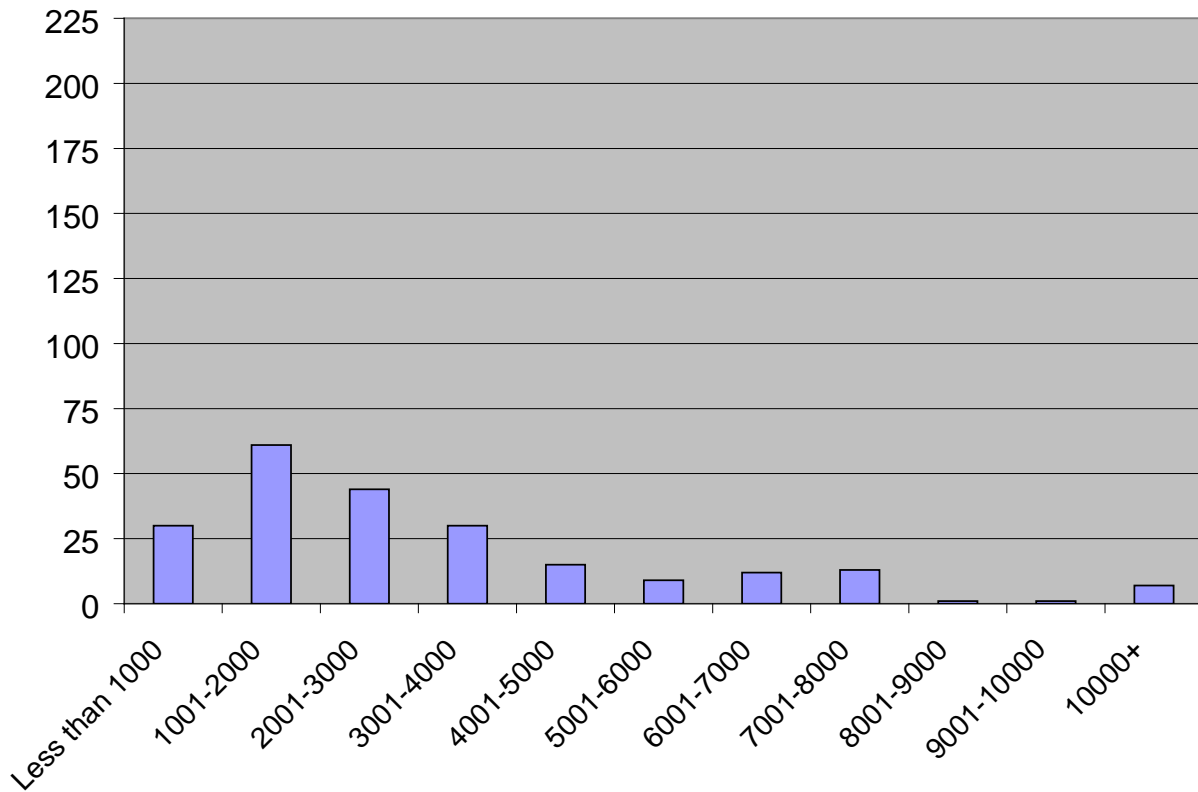
- Yes, all students are required to purchase a computer which meets our standards but not necessarily from the university

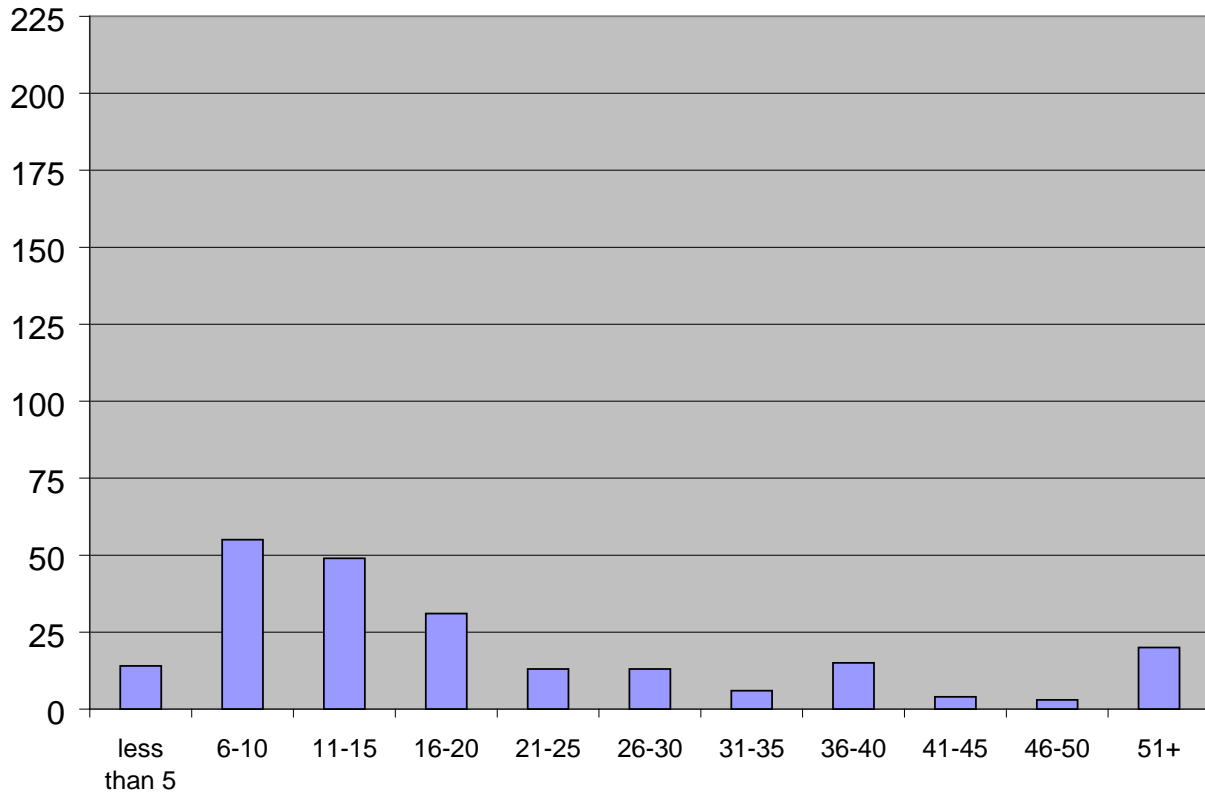

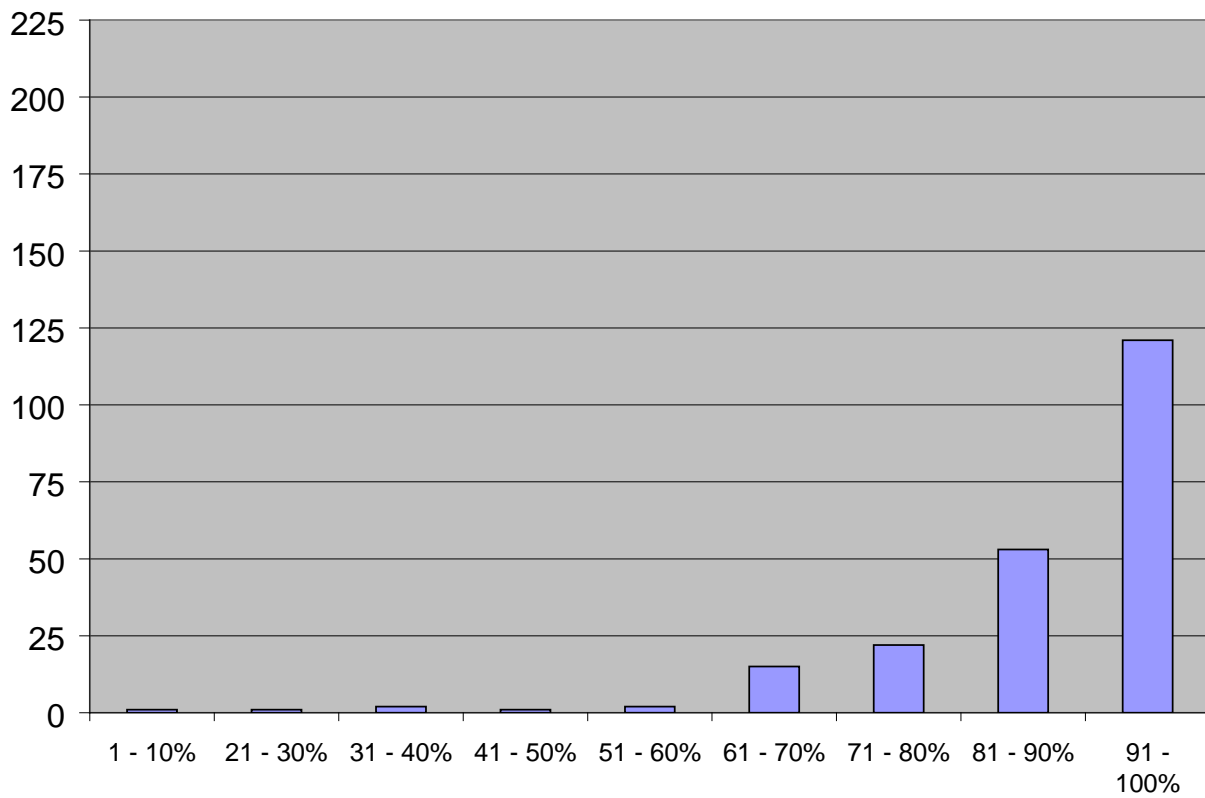

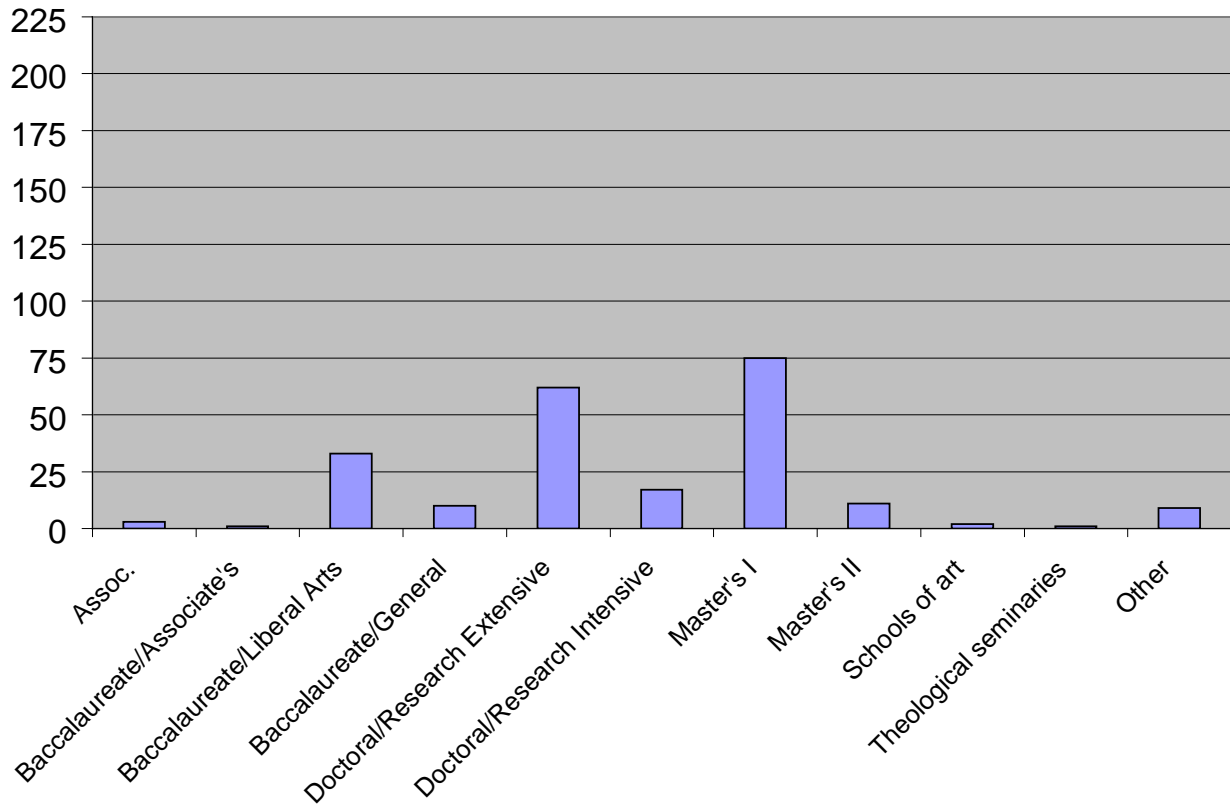

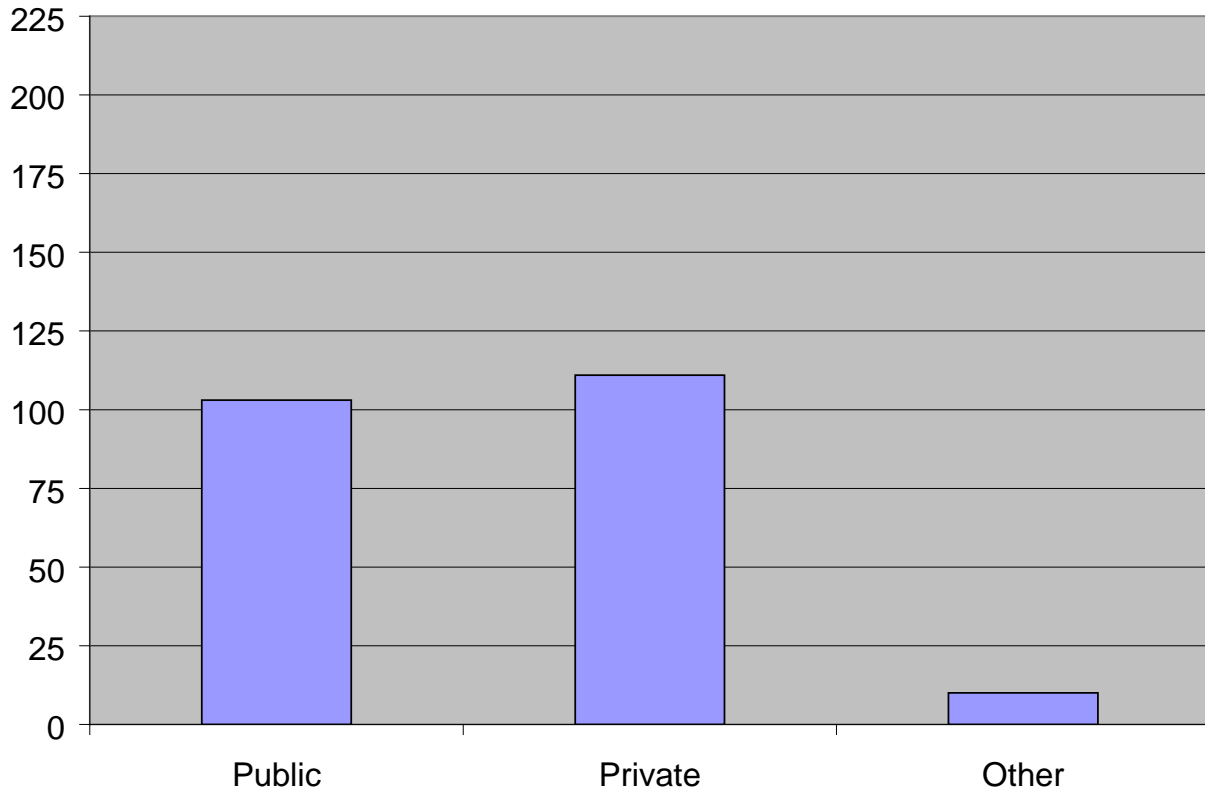

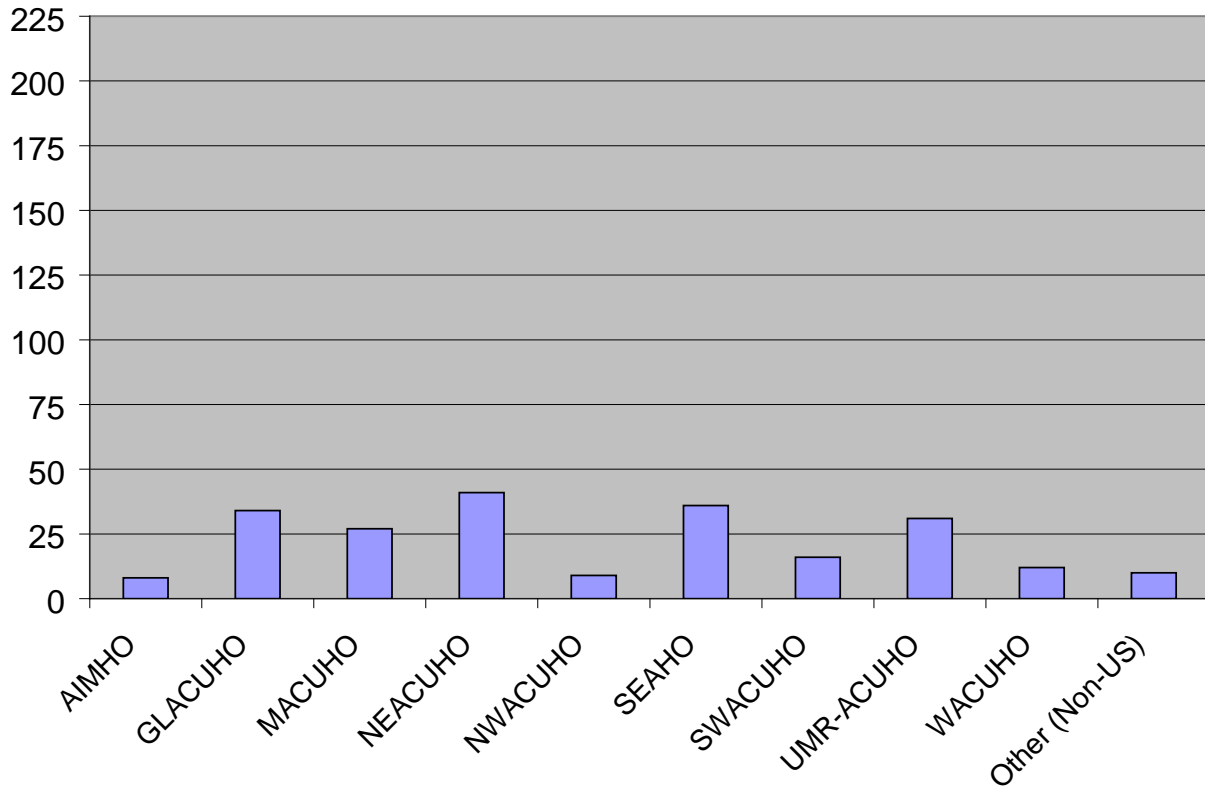

Data added post-survey: Governance



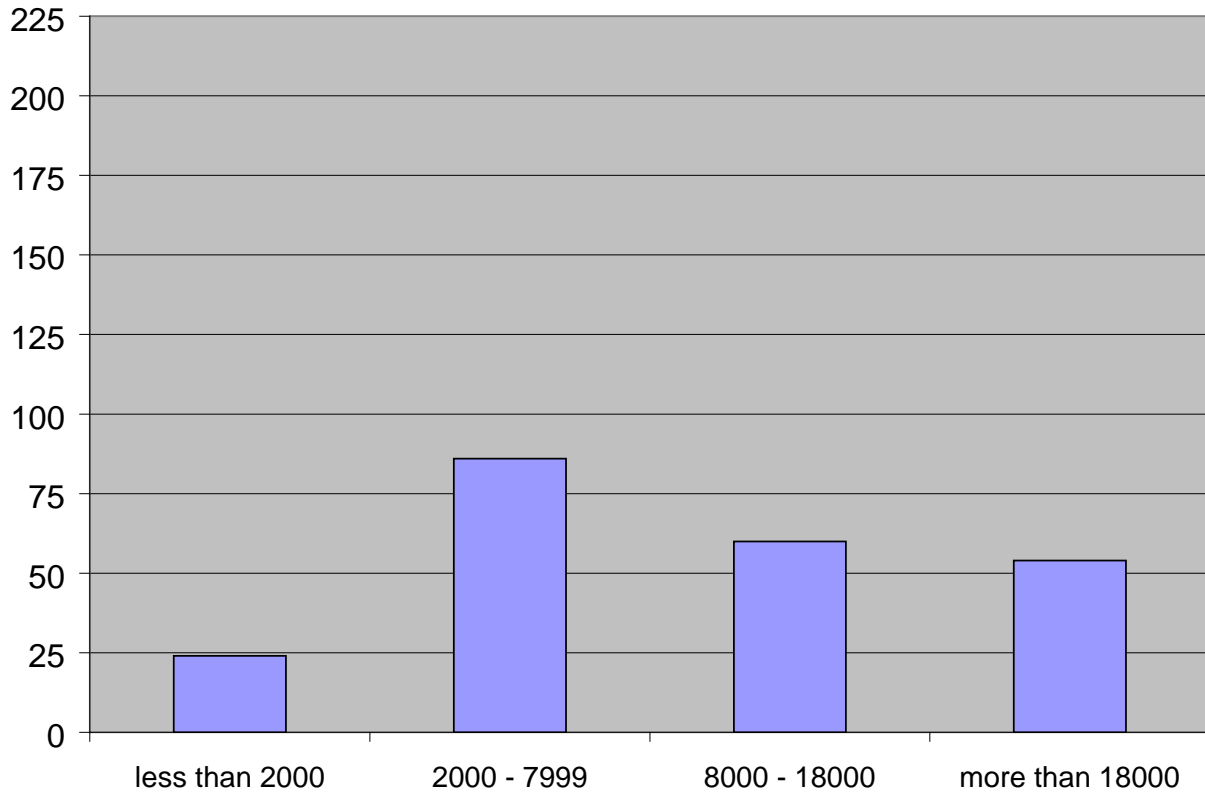
